

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-24

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT CITY
ESTABLISHING A REDUCED FEE FOR PLANNING COMMISSION REVIEW OF MURALS**

WHEREAS, the City of Crescent City is a general law city incorporated in 1854 and governed by the general laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, General Plan Policy 1.J.14 states that the City shall encourage and assist in the development of murals to enliven blank walls in the areas designated Visitor and Local Commercial (VLC) and Business Professional (B-P); and

WHEREAS, murals with no commercial message are allowed in all nonresidential zones, and on commercial use buildings in the residential-professional zones (CCMC § 17.39.160(A)) if they are consistent with the City's three central themes: Redwood National Park, Seacoast Fishing Village, and Crescent City's Historical Past (e.g. 1964 Tsunami) (General Plan Policy 1.J.14); and

WHEREAS, murals are categorized as "community promotional signs" and must have approval of the Planning Commission (CCMC § 17.39.160(A)); and


WHEREAS, murals are considered "architecturally controlled signs" and subject to the current \$500 minor Architectural Design Review fee; and

WHEREAS, a separate fee must be established in order to reduce the fee applicable to planning commission review of murals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT CITY that an architectural design review fee for murals is hereby established in the amount of \$200.
