Chief Carey reported that Crescent City Fire & Rescue (CCFR) utilizes mutual aid during times of natural disaster and other emergency incidents from various mutual aid response resources. One response partner is the California Department of Correction and Rehabilitation/Pelican Bay State Prison Fire Department (PBSPFD). This mutual aid response assistance has been in place for many years, primarily benefitting CCFR and the citizens of our community.

Chief Carey also stated that recently, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation has required their facilities to establish mutual aid response agreements with those departments with which they have already worked mutual aid. It was noted that there is no foreseeable fiscal impact through the signing of this agreement.

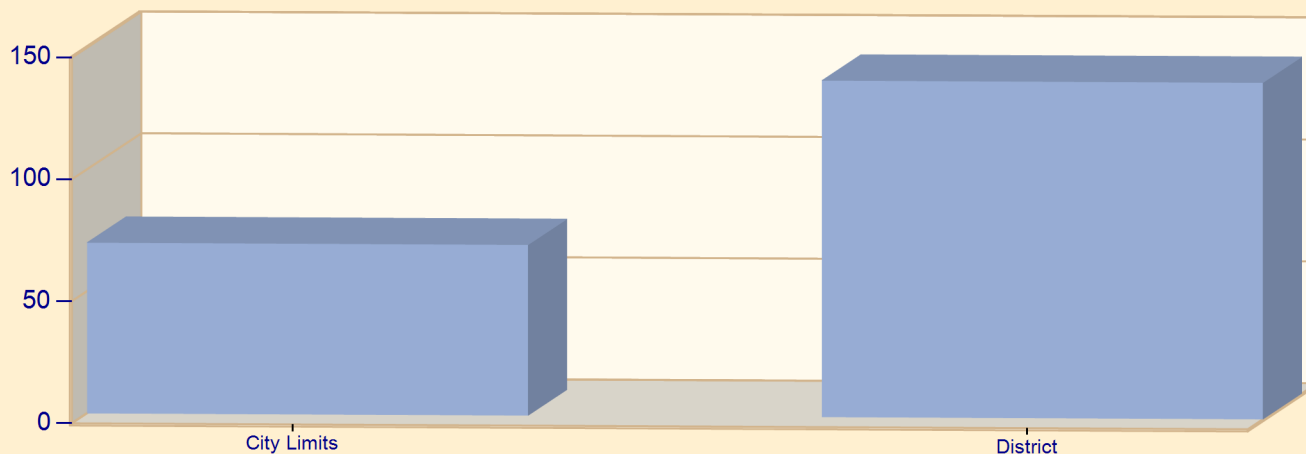

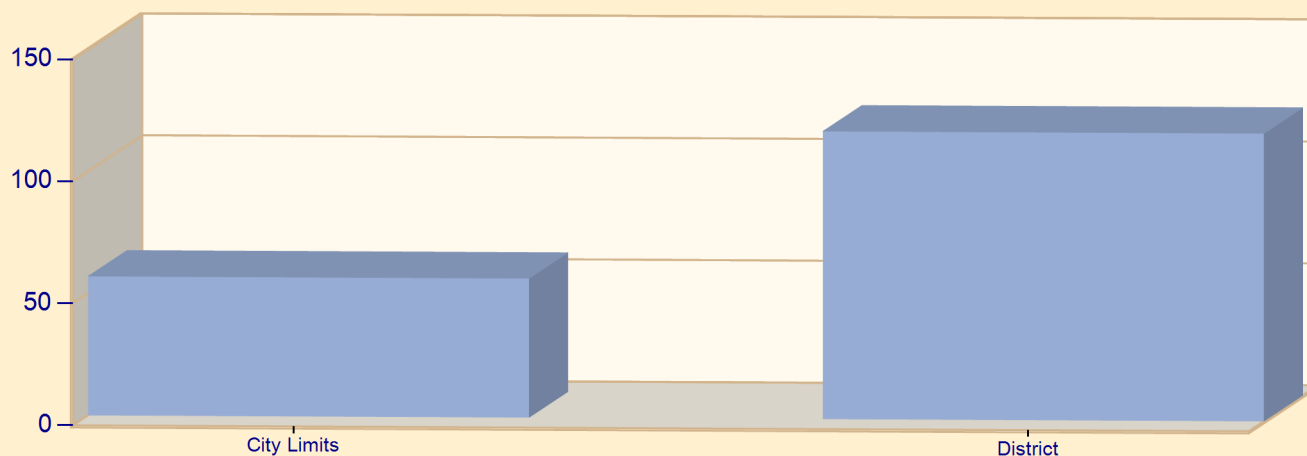

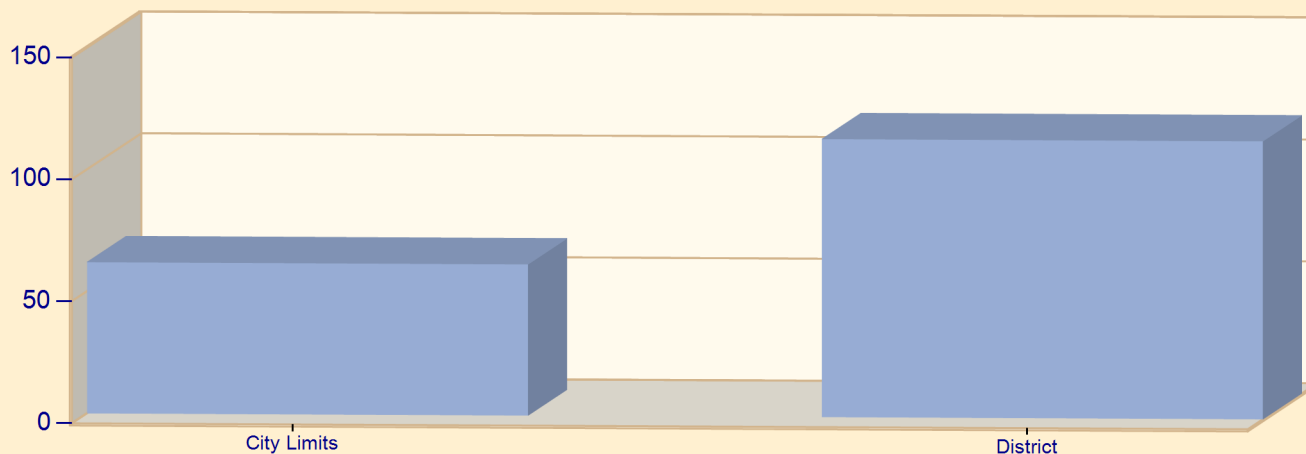
