Design Committee Meeting – Walkaround Downtown for Tiny Art Project

We will not meet in July, but rather each committee member is asked to:

- Walk downtown (Lookerman Street and any one adjacent block in either direction - North or South of Lookerman) to find deferred maintenance conditions/blemishes viewable to the public that could be suitable for an artist to beautify.
- Take a photo (or a couple) of the area(s) and note the location.

The August 13 meeting will be a walkaround downtown to review what has been collected by the group. We will allow not more than 90 minutes for this walkaround.

From this, we will determine most suitable (6 – 10) sites for the tiny art project.

We have funds in hand to pay six artist \$500 each, but we may want to promote more sites so that there are options for artists to consider. (In fact, we could even offer artists an opportunity to do a project pro bono, for those inclined to do so.)

In preparation for the August 13 walkaround:

- **Send your images, each labeled with the location, in an email to me no later than **Monday Aug. 11** so that we can devise a path for the walkaround to select the project sites.**
