Feedback:

- **Holiday sales**: Josie indicated very good; Lori's sales were very good; Dina believed that there were more people downtown than previous years; Tom's sales were down.
- Promotional passport Josie, Tom and Lori indicated very little response with the promo books.

Window Decorating contest

- There was lot of feedback about the beauty of downtown holiday lighting...people loved it!
- Feb. any holiday Superbowl, groundhog, Valentine's day Presidents, Black History Month, and any other merchants would like to celebrate.
- \$100 will be offered for Feb., as with other. Chamber will do the judging on the 4th of Feb. in early evening, so merchants have windows decorated, with lights on, by noon on Feb. 4. The Design committee did the December judging, as is always done. 28th entry form is due by Monday Jan. 20th.

Other business:

- For the Green area merchants, the summer visitors (many by bus) generally don't have negative feelings about the downtown (parking, safety, etc.) and they could be a population to grow into downtown.
