In prior years, the Safety Advisory and Transportation Committee proactively contacted the State of Delaware Department of Transportation to express our support of various transportation related improvements within the City of Dover. Staff has reviewed DelDOT’s project development list for FY-2006 thru FY-2011 and developed the following priorities (based on past ranking, traffic needs, MPO ranking, project timelines and funding).

1. Wyoming Mill Road Realignment
2. Governors Avenue Corridor Upgrades – Water Street to Webbs Lane
3. Downtown Dover Signalization Upgrades
4. Loockerman Street / Forrest Avenue Improvements
5. West Dover Connector Study
6. Kenton Road Corridor Upgrades
7. College Road Corridor Upgrades
8. U.S. 13 Sidewalk Construction
9. Crawford Carroll Avenue Extension
