### **PURCHASE OF CPR MANIKINS FOR TRAINING IN SCHOOLS**

Corporal (Cpl.) Anthony Smith, PAL Coordinator advised the Board that PAL received a donation from the Masonic Lodge for \$3,000.00 and that he would like to use that donation towards to purchase of CPR Manikins for upcoming training. Cpl. Smith further advised that he currently uses the manikins from the schools or his own personal ones and that he would like PAL to have their own. Cpl. Smith mentioned that he has an upcoming CPR Training Event that he needs the manikins for and he would like to provide food and shirts/hoodies to the participants as well, he estimates the price to be about \$3,600.00.

Mr. Baird moved to approve the expenditure of \$3,600.00 for the purchase of CPR Manikins, and for food and clothing for the next PAL CPR Training Event, seconded by Dr. Jackson and unanimously carried.

The gun locks were donated thru the Project ChildSafe Program and will be available, while supplies last, on September 28, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. to Noon in the James L. Hutchison Public Assembly Room located in the Dover Police Department.

Cpl. Smith responded to Chief Johnson that no financial reports were due until 2025.

With no further business Mr. Baird moved to adjourn the meeting seconded by Dr. Jackson and unanimously carried.
