Robin Adolphsen, City Engineer requests Council approve Pine Street to be striped for angled parking so that there will be more parking available for large events. The street is appropriate for this as it is a 60' wide street.

Council carried a motion to ALLOW RESTRIPIING PINE STREET FROM 7TH AVENUE TO 11TH AVENUE WITH A BUDGET OF \$15,000. M/S Dorow/Valdez
