TOWN OF LANTANA REGULAR MEETING MINUTES February 11, 2019

1. ROLL CALL:

<u>Mayor Stewart</u> called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and <u>Mrs. Trent</u> called the roll. There was a moment of silent prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. <u>Mayor Stewart</u> asked that the family, friends and neighbors of Ken and Alice Simmons be remembered.

ALSO PRESENT: Deborah S. Manzo, Town Manager; Mrs. Trent, Deputy Town Clerk; R. Max Lohman, Legal Counsel and approximately 10 spectators.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

<u>Councilmember Balfour</u> made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes of January 28, 2019. <u>Vice Mayor Shropshire</u> seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

3. AGENDA APPROVAL:

<u>Councilmember Aridas</u> made a motion to approve the agenda as submitted. <u>Councilmember Moorhouse</u> seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

4. STAFF AND COMMITTEE REPORTS:

a. Council Reports

<u>Councilmember Moorhouse</u> stated the staff did a heck of a job decorating Stephen Kaplan's office for his birthday.

b. Town Manager Report

<u>Town Manager Manzo</u> stated that about 85 people attended the Movie Night on February 8th. She reported that the IPS parking kiosk has been installed at Bicentennial Park and said there are now four locations in Town with kiosks.

a. Consideration of Ordinance O-03-2019 amending Chapter 10. of the Town Code of Ordinances in order to delete Section 10-1 which has been determined to be obsolete. **Remarks: Second Reading.**

<u>Mayor Stewart</u> introduced and explained this item on the agenda and asked for disclosures. <u>Councilmember Aridas, Councilmember Balfour</u> and <u>Vice Mayor Shropshire</u> disclosed they spoke to the Town Manager. There were no other Council disclosures.

LEGISLATION; PROVIDING THAT THE REMAINDER OF CHAPTER 10. SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS PREVIOUSLY ENACTED; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND AN AUTHORITY TO CODIFY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

b. Consideration of Ordinance O-06-2019 amending Chapter 23. of the Town Code of Ordinances in order to revise lot coverage and lot width regulations in R1A and R15 Districts. **Remarks: First Reading.**

<u>Mayor Stewart</u> introduced and explained this item on the agenda and asked for disclosures. <u>Vice Mayor Shropshire</u> disclosed he spoke to the Town Manager. <u>Mayor Stewart</u> disclosed he spoke to his wife and to Ken Hilgendorf. There were no other Council disclosures.

AT SECTION 23-2. SCOPE AND AUTHORITY OF ZONING REGULATIONS; ZONING MAP. AT SUBSECTION (b) TO AMEND THE REFERENCE TO THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP: FURTHER AMENDING CHAPTER 23. AT SECTION 23-47. SITE PLAN REQUIREMENTS. BY REPEALING SUBSECTIONS (c)(1).p AND (c)(2).d AND READOPTING SAME, AS REVISED TO REQUIRE THAT SIDEWALKS BE INCLUDED IN ALL SITE PLANS; FURTHER AMENDING CHAPTER 23. AT SECTION 23-92. R1A RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT. SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS PREVIOUSLY ENACTED; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND AUTHORITY TO CODIFY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

EXCEPTIONS TO LOCATION RESTRICTIONS. BY REPEALING SECTION 3-3 AND READOPTING SAME, AS REVISED; PROVIDING THAT THE REMAINDER OF CHAPTER 3.
