MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE

ARKANSAS STATE GAME AND FISH COMMISSION

AND

CITY OF BENTON, ARKANSAS

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into between the ARKANSAS STATE GAME AND FISH COMMISSION (hereinafter referred to as "AGFC" or the "Commission") and CITY OF BENTON, ARKANSAS (hereinafter referred to as the "Cooperator").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Amendment 35 to the Constitution of Arkansas, AGFC is vested with the control, management, restoration, conservation and regulation of the birds, fish, game and wildlife resources of the State and the administration of the laws pertaining thereto. The mission of the Commission is to conserve and enhance Arkansas's fish and wildlife and their habitats while promoting sustainable use, public understanding and support; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperator is a municipal corporation. Cooperator owns or controls the Sunset Lake and has full legal authority to provide, and by this Agreement does provide, AGFC and the public access to and use of such waters and the associated facilities for the purposes and under the conditions set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Cooperator and AGFC to cooperate for the purpose of providing angling opportunities and the opportunity for finical assistance for maintenance and enhancements to the ponds within the City of Benton. In particular, the goal of this agreement is for Cooperator to provide ponds that are maintained and easily accessible to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperator is the fee owner of the Sunset Lake located in Benton in Saline County, Arkansas, and is depicted on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Sunset Lake located in Sunset Park is part of the AGFC Family and Community Pond Fishing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, AGFC and the Cooperator, in exchange for the mutual obligations and covenants contained herein, agree as follows:

I. Scope of Agreement

A. The AGFC agrees to:

1. Provide to the Cooperator consultation through an AGFC Regional Maintenance Contract Coordinator and an AGFC District Fisheries Biologist.

- Provide regular stockings of fish for the Sunset Lake through the AGFC hatchery system in accordance with the guidance of the AGFC Family and Community Fishing Program staff. If AGFC deems a pond not suitable to stock, fish will be either decreased or relocated to another suitable location.
- 3. Provide to the Cooperator up to \$30,000 during the term of this Agreement for the Cooperator's use in offsetting the cost of improvements and maintenance for the Sunset Lake.

B. The Cooperator agrees to:

- 1. Grant AGFC and its agents, employees and assigns, permission to enter on, over and across the proposed site for the purposes set forth herein.
- 2. Be responsible for ensuring that all required local, state and federal permits, easements, and rights of way are obtained, and that all proper licensing and approval requirements are met for the work-in-kind associated with this agreement.
- 3. Accept sole responsibility for all manner of claims, causes of action or liability arising out of any accident, injury or damage to the Cooperator, its equipment or property, its employees or agents, and to any third party's person or property while conducting any activity related to this Agreement. AGFC shall not be liable for injuries or damages because of any action of any individual or organization in connection with this work.
- 4. To the extent permitted by Arkansas law, hold harmless, defend, and indemnify AGFC, its Commissioners, Director, and employees from or against for any and all claims, judgments, causes of action, liability, damages, and expenses of whatsoever nature incident to, or resulting from, the Cooperator's activities or performance under this Agreement. Furthermore, notwithstanding the foregoing, the Cooperator agrees that: (a) it will cooperate with AGFC in the defense of any action or claim brought against AGFC seeking the foregoing damages or relief; (b) it will in good faith cooperate with AGFC should any third party present any claims of the foregoing nature against AGFC to the Claims Commission of the State of Arkansas; (c) it will not take any action to frustrate or delay the prompt hearing on claims of the foregoing nature. This Agreement shall be deemed and construed as binding solely between the two parties and shall not be deemed or construed as conferring any benefit or indemnification on behalf of any third party. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed or construed as an admission of liability or as a waiver of any sovereign immunity of either party. The obligations of this paragraph shall survive the expiration or termination of this Agreement.
- 5. Be solely responsible for the maintenance, repair, and operation of the Sunset Lake and its infrastructure, specifically including maintaining, repairing, and operating any water control structure and on-site pumps used to maintain the water level; routine mowing, grounds-keeping, and refuse removal; and monitoring and managing water levels at levels conducive to fishery management goals.
- 6. Except in the case of emergency, keep the Sunset Lake open to the public at all times "free of charge" for recreational fishing.
- 7. Consult with an AGFC staff biologist or contracted biologist on renovations or modifications to a pond or water control structure (i.e. pond levees, dam or well). Consult with AGFC biologist on

funding and if funds are available either partial or full funding, provide AGFC receipts for weed control (fertilizers or lime), renovations, or modifications to the pond (i.e. installing/repairing fishing piers, aerators, levees, or boat ramps).

- 8. Allow AGFC biologists to sample and manage fish populations as a way to improve angling for all.
- 9. Use the latest marketing and advertising strategies to allow AGFC and conservation partners to promote Family and Community Fishing Programs at or for this location.

II. Term

This Agreement shall become effective as soon as signed by both parties and shall remain in force until **May 1st, 2028**, unless terminated earlier in accordance with its terms herein.

III. Termination

This Agreement may be terminated by mutual consent of the parties, or by one party upon thirty (30) days written notice. Any such termination of the Agreement is without prejudice to any obligations or liabilities of either party already accrued prior to such termination.

IV. Amendment

Amendments to this Agreement may be proposed by either party upon written notice to the other party, and such amendments shall become effective as soon as signed by both parties hereto.

VI. Miscellaneous

A. The parties agree that they are not entering into a legal partnership, joint venture or other such arrangement, nor is the purpose of the parties to enter into a commercial undertaking for

- monetary gain. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to place a financial commitment or obligation upon either of the parties.
- B. It is the intent of the parties that Arkansas Code Ann. §18-11-304 through §18-11-306 shall be applicable to the fullest extent of the law so that AGFC and the Cooperator shall not be liable or responsible in any manner for any personal injury, whether resulting in death or not, nor for any property loss or damage, sustained or alleged to have been sustained by any person or persons whomsoever, whether such person or persons shall be on the subject lands or water with the permission or at the sufferance of the Cooperator or AGFC.
- C. By the signing of this Agreement, the parties assure and certify that they will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (P-L88-352) and that in accordance with that Act, no person in the United States shall, on grounds of race, color, or national origin be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subject to discrimination in this project.
- D. The officials executing this Agreement hereby represent and warrant that they have full and complete authority to act on behalf of the Cooperator and the Commission, respectively, and that the terms and provisions hereof constitute valid and enforceable obligations of each.
- E. This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas. With respect to any claim for monetary damages against the Commission, the appropriate venue shall be in the Arkansas State Claims Commission, Pulaski County, Arkansas.
- F. No transfer or assignment of this Agreement, or any part thereof or interest therein, shall be made unless all of the parties first approve such transfer or assignment in writing.
- G. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. There are no understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified within this Agreement.





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

ORDINANCE NO. 7 OF 2024

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING BENTON UTILTIES TO PURCHASE A WALL MOUNT M400B2 BASE STATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

SECTION 2: The requirement of competitive bidding for the purchase hereby authorized is deemed not feasible or practical and, therefore, is waived.
