	 The site contains precautionary slopes in excess of 15%. However, the property is an R-60 Zone, which is exempt from the Steep Slope Ordinance. 	
	 Existing coverage of 31.9%; proposed coverage of 46.4% when 40% is allowed. VEC recommended a slight reduction of the scope of the project. 	
	 The Applicant proposes to use permeable pavers; the VEC recommends appropriate spacing for the best infiltration outcome.
