Subject: Amendments to the 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program

The following changes are proposed for the CNVMPO's 2025-2028 TIP.

Project No. 0170-3791 – BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS; VARIOUS BRIDGES AFTER PPP

CTDOT has proposed adding project 0170-3791 to the 2025-2028 TIP. The purpose of this project is to address deck deterioration for various bridges in Districts 3 and 4. The need for this project is to repair/replace the membrane waterproofing systems and address any other minor deterioration within the bridges as a follow up to pavement preservation projects. The membrane and overlay will protect the concrete deck from damaging moisture and de-icing salts, thereby extending the service life of the bridge deck. Within the CNVMPO, these bridges are mostly located along I-84 and ramps within the City of Waterbury.

Funding

Funding levels and sources for all projects are identified on the next pages in the report generated by EcoInteractive. Additionally, each project's specific locations are included on the attached maps. These projects have been posted to the CNVMPO's EcoInteractive public page and are available for comment up to the meeting's commencement, at which time staff will relay any received comments.



AMENDMENT FFY 2025-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM CENTRAL NAUGATUCK VALLEY MPO

WHEREAS, the Central Naugatuck Valley MPO is authorized by the *Infrastructure Investment* and Jobs Act (IIJA) and related US Department of Transportation regulations to prepare, endorse, and periodically amend a short-range Transportation Improvement Program for the 15-town MPO within the Waterbury Urbanized Area and is required to maintain a fiscally constrained program of priority projects; and

WHEREAS, the CNVMPO endorsed the FFY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program for the Central Naugatuck Valley Planning Region (TIP) at its April 19, 2024, meeting; and the US Department of Transportation (Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration) have approved the State FFY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (STIP); and

WHEREAS, the projects within the TIP are being changed by the project sponsors in the way demonstrated on the attached sheets; and

WHEREAS, the proposed projects have been reviewed for compliance with air quality conformity and either are exempted under federal legislation or have been found in compliance; and

WHEREAS, the public notification and review of these amendments was consistent with and followed the procedures set forth in the MPO's public involvement guidelines, the proposed changes were posted for public review and comment to the EcoInteractive Portal for the CNVMPO prior to consideration, and the proposed amendments are consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan for the Central Naugatuck Valley planning region;

BE IT RESOLVED that Central Naugatuck Valley MPO approves the amendments of projects 0170-3791 as demonstrated in the attached sheets of the FFY 2025-2028 TIP.
