TARGET AUDIENCE

Based on our most recent data, our largest visiting age group is 25-34 year old and in close second is 0-17, so Derby will realize very young and vibrant visitors and families to the area. We will also see a big increase in new paddlers because of the perception that the river is safer, as well as, many more bikers who prefer off-street biking to the perils of road biking.

BEACH CLEAN UP

As a member of and in coordination with Surfrider Foundation, Scoot & Paddle will conduct a river cleanup at least once per season and more as needed in which we would invite the entire community to be a part of. By bringing awareness to the importance of protecting our waterways and inviting our youth to be a part of volunteering and community service we can create an ongoing sustainable positive environmental impact.



LOCATION

Hog Island (peninsula) is the ideal location for rentals as there is both access to water for watersports and a trail head for biking or scooting as well as a free parking lot. There is space for boats to be stored close to the water and offers a safe launchable site large enough to coordinate multiple boats coming and going at any given time. The island sits right at the confluence of two rivers and therefore offers optimum access to river exploration. It is also right beside the Greenway trailhead which is an off-road bike trail allowing customers to pick up and drop off equipment quickly and easily. The city of Derby has proposed a lease of \$1.00 for the first trial year as we work to implement a plan that works for everyone and around the current construction areas. We hope to work together to build a safe exciting space for visitors and residents alike.









REQUIREMENTS

• Storage (year one): (2) 8x20 metal storage containers would be utilized. One to store boats, paddleboards, PDFs, paddles and other accessories as well as a second container for bicycles, scooters, helmets and accessories that can be securely locked when business is closed *see site plan for locations

- 10x10 sales tent near parking lot/trail head with banner/booth
- Staging area for bicycles and scooters near trail head
- Graded launching area for kayaks and paddleboards at tip of Hog Island
- Staging area for kayaks and paddleboards near launch zone
- 10x10 tent at launch area for protection from the elements for staff
- Port-o-let for staff and customer use in/near parking lot
- Clear directional signage along route during construction phase beginning on Main St. and leading to Hog Island

Art installations, drinking fountains, shade stations, garbage bins and picnic areas along the Greenway would greatly increase visitor experience. Bike racks at trailheads and bike repair stations as found on other bike trails is a good idea. Community events, with activities and educational components can be held on O'Sullivan Island to promote the area and to continue the culture of progress you have begun therefore creating a vibrant, active, involved community for the future of Derby.
