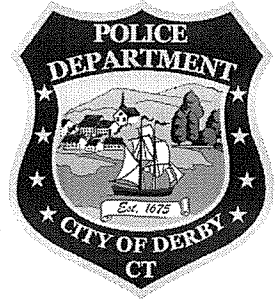

A meeting of the Derby Board of Police Commissioners was held on April 14, 2025 at the Derby Police Department, 125 Water Street, Derby, CT.

The meeting was called to order at 6:04PM by Commissioner DeGennaro.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

2. Roll Call

Present were Commissioners DeGennaro and Gloade. Also present was Chief Todd.

3. Public Portion

No one from the public spoke.

4. Adoption of Agenda

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to adopt the agenda. Commissioner Gloade seconded and the motion carried.

5. Acceptance of Previous Meeting's Minutes

Commissioner Gloade motioned to accept the 10 MAR 25 minutes. Commissioner DeGennaro seconded and the motion carried.

7. New Business

8. Department Reports

Chief Todd reviewed the monthly patrol activity where there was not much change from the previous month. He also reviewed the budget, and noted transfers within the department have been made to the Overtime budget line to cover the overtime needed due to the staffing levels.

9. Communications

No communications to discuss.

10. Traffic Authority Business

Commissioner DeGennaro let Chief Todd know about cars parking on one side of Derby Ave. Chief Todd noted that since Derby Ave is a state road, the department has no authority to put up any signs, however he will have it looked into to see if a recommendation can be made to the State.
