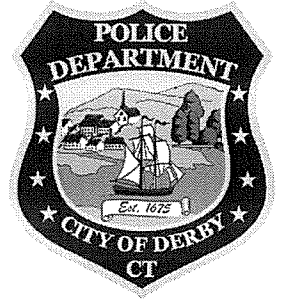

A meeting of the Derby Board of Police Commissioners was held on October 7, 2024 at the Derby Police Department, 125 Water Street, Derby, CT.

The meeting was called to order at 6:03PM by Commissioner DeGennaro.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

2. Roll Call

Present were Commissioners DeGennaro, Lenart and Gloade. Also present was Chief Todd and Deputy Chief Grogan.

3. Public Portion

No one from the public spoke.

4. Adoption of Agenda

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to adopt the agenda with the addition of new Grievance 24-04 under New Business. Commissioner Gloade seconded and the motion carried.

5. Acceptance of Previous Meeting's Minutes

Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to accept the 09 SEP 24 minutes. Commissioner Gloade seconded and the motion carried.

7. New Business

Grievance 24-04 was discussed. Chief Todd explained this a continuation of other grievances the Union has filed against the City for failing to abide by the contractual stipulations for Worker's Comp payment, and recommended it be denied as the decision is made at the Mayor's level. Commissioner DeGennaro motioned to deny the grievance. Commissioner Gloade seconded and the motion carried.

Chief Todd recommended Sergeant Massetti for promotion to the open Lieutenant position based on testing results and being the most qualified candidate. The Commissioners requested to review the employee files of the top three candidates before proceeding with the promotion. Commissioner Gloade motioned to table the promotion until the files have been reviewed. Commissioner DeGennaro seconded and the motion carried.

8. Department Reports

Chief Todd reviewed the patrol activity and there was nothing significant to report. Deputy Chief Grogan went over the budget, the Overtime line continues to be overspent by 10% due to three officers being out, however two of them have just returned to light duty while the third one is still out on Worker's Comp for another month. Recruit Canedo is finishing Phase 4, while recruit Roberts is scheduled to start his FTO today, and there is still one more hire needed.

9. Communications

No communications to discuss.

10. Traffic Authority Business

Chief Todd briefed the Commissioners on a meeting with the Mayor, Chief of Staff and residents of Third St. regarding parking concerns due to the new apartment buildings since the previously used lot for parking has been purchased by the owner of the apartments. No action to be taken at this time.

11. Adjournment

Commissioner Lenart motioned to adjourn at 6:34PM. Commissioner Gloade seconded and the motion carried.
