Review of Dash Board

Mr. McLiverty presented the board with a copy or the Dashboard Monthly Report as of February 18, 2020. He explained all of the line items, Revenue and Expenditures, adding that there will be one addition in the future and that will be Police Department Expenses, and this will be shown under line item #001-3100-110-0012. The Board was pleased with the report.

Budget Procedure, Status and Advisory: Discussion of Budget Process and Format

Ms. Scewczyk said that the Budget would be sent out to all department heads by the middle of March. The Board would like everyone to hold to the "0" base line. The discussion was whether or not to have everyone come in and present their budgets, and it was decided that everyone would be allotted 10 minutes each, with the departments with larger budgets would need their own times for presentations.

Discussion and Possible Action: Payden Field House Electricity Line (4200-230-0239)

Mr. McLiverty explained to the Board, that the electricity line item is already at \$12,000.00 which was budgeted. The reason is the lights are on 24/7 for protection. They will be meeting with the electric company to see what can be done to lessen the costs. Mr. Coppolo asked about money from rental of the field house and Mr. McLiverty said the Board of Alderman has not made a decision as to the cost and what else is involved in renting the field house and therefore there have been no rentals yet. They are also looking at the cost of cable. There is a shortfall of \$4,200.00 in the electricity. Mr. McLiverty proposed the following changes:
