Commissioner Gloade briefed the commission on the meeting he attended with the Naugatuck Valley Council of Governments regarding the status of the intersection of High Street and Academy Hill which is with the state as well as the traffic by the Recreation camp whereas the state will be doing a study of both. Chief Narowski also briefed on the intersection of High Street and Academy Hill that is with NVCOG in which they have one engineer as well as traffic consultants which will be able to do a traffic study and put up a couple of counters to see where the traffic is going. Also they will be looking into the accident database a little further to determine what the problems are that are causing these accidents. Once they gather the information they will get back to this department with their findings. He also briefed on the

Recreation Camp status. Both studies are in the state's hands and are awaiting the results of both.
