PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

The Public Works Committee of Wheeling City Council met on the above date at 3:30 p.m. in City Council Chambers. Committee members present: Chair Sklavounakis, Vice Chair Seidler, and Member Thorngate. Others present: City Manager Robert Herron, Public Works Director Rusty Jebbia, Andy Harris WPCD, Joe Smith WPCD, and City Clerk Brenda J. Delbert.

The following matters were discussed:

Discussion on Storm and Sewer System Projects

Mr. Jebbia gives overview of priority projects that need completed within the city. Projects are part of Long-Term Control plan to relieve sewer and storm systems from overburdened. Mr. Jebbia suggests various projects to separate storm and sewer lines to alleviate basement flooding in neighborhoods. Some of the projects include: Valley View, Gaewood Section of Elm Terrace, Greenwood, Nutal Ave, 22nd St., 40th St., 38th St., South Huron, Overbrook, Elm Run, 37th St. Mr. Harris reviews sewer projects, and cites concerns with rising costs in Warwood Project, and DEP involvement. It was noted funding for some sewer projects has been allocated through Phase III B bond issuance however, funding is still needed to cover all priority projects.
