WHEELING TRAFFIC COMMISSION October 13, 2022

The Wheeling Traffic Commission met on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. the following were present: **Commission Members:** Lloyd Adams, Pat Duffy (absent), Andrew Hollis, Ron King, and Jeff Knierim (absent). **City Staff:** Brenda J. Delbert, Fire Department, Police Department and Bill Lanham.

Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Adams, to approve the minutes from August 11, 2022. Motion carried. All in favor.

Request for Removal of tour bus zone in front of 30 - 22nd Street and replaced with two-hour parking meters. Mr. Lanham indicated city staff has measured the intersection and supports the request. Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved to forward the following recommendation to City Council: The City Manager is hereby authorized to remove tour bus zone in front of 30 22nd Street by adding two two-hour parking meters. Motion carried. All in favor.

Request to changing parking meters from 30 minutes to 2 hours on the north side of 22nd Street in front of the former WesBanco Bank drive through. Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved to forward the following recommendation to City Council: The City Manager is hereby authorized to change parking meters from 30 minutes to two hours on the north side of 22nd Street in front of the former WesBanco Bank drive through. Motion carried. All in favor.

Request to add two-hour parking meters on the north side of 23rd street at the corner of Market and 23rd. Mr. Lanham indicated the garage does not open and is not being utilized. City staff has measured the area and believed 2 2-hour meters will fit location. Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved to forward the following recommendation to City Council: The City Manager is hereby authorized to add two-hour parking meters on the north side of 23rd street at the corner of Market and 23rd. Motion carried. All in favor.

Request to remove Tour Bus Parking Zone at the Corner of 14th and Market St. In front of River City Main Entrance. A discussion ensued about how many meters will fit due to bump outs related to upcoming streetscape project. For the record Traffic Commission supports removing the sign and adding additional meters. However, the decision was made to wait until after project completion.

There being no further business, Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Hollis, moved to adjourn.
