## WHEELING TRAFFIC COMMISSION January 12, 2023

The Wheeling Traffic Commission met on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. the following were present: **Commission Members:** Lloyd Adams, Pat Duffy (absent), Andrew Hollis, Ron King, and Jeff Knierim. **City Staff:** Bill Lanham and Jordan Starr.

Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Adams, to approve the minutes from November 10, 2022. Motion carried. All in favor.

Request for no parking on both sides of B Street in Warwood Terrace. A discussion ensued surrounding the difficulty of turning and concern for EMS and Sanitation vehicles. Portions on B Street, from Highland Ave to Clifton Ave are currently no parking. Mr. Knierim, seconded by Mr. King, moved to forward the following recommendation to City Council: City Manager is hereby authorized to create a no parking fire zone from Nuttel to Clifton Ave. Motion carried. All in favor.

Request for meters on 11th St. at the intersection of Chaplin and 11th convert from 1- hour parking meters to 5-hour meters. Lori Jones, YWCA Director, indicated she needs more parking for employees and tenants. Applicant was present and indicated two meters directly in front of location recently were converted to "no parking." City staff will find out cause for removal of meters. A discussion ensued on how to help accommodate staff parking. Mr. Lanham indicated there are spaces available to rent in lot 6 and the potential for additional meters or permit parking zone. Mr. Knierim, seconded by Mr. King, moved to table the request while staff investigated issues. Motion carried. All in favor.

Discussion on location of three reserved spaces for Combat Wounded. VFW Post 4442 in Elm Grove has started a Purple Heart Parking Project and gifted the city three signs to convert regular parking spaces to reserved to Combat Wounded. Mr. Knierim, seconded by Mr. King, moved to forward the following recommendation to City Council: City Manager is hereby authorized to convert three meters located at (1) City/County Building, (2) Heritage Port, (3) Helping Heroes. Motion carried. All in favor.

There being no further business, Mr. Knierim, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved to adjourn.
