

## WHEELING TRAFFIC COMMISSION – June 12, 2018

The Wheeling Traffic Commission met for its monthly business meeting on the above date in City Council Chambers with Acting Chair Duvall presiding. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Member Duffy moved, seconded by Member King, to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2018 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

### NEW BUSINESS

Request by Donald Gaus, 4 Austin Ave, for handicapped parking space in front of residence. Mrs. Gaus was present to speak on behalf of request. Member King, seconded by Member Duffy to recommend the following traffic rule to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE: 4671: TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE IN THE SOUTH SIDE OF AUSTIN AVENUE DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 4 AUSTIN AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON AUSTIN AVENUE FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET

Request by Kimberly Cecil, 3834 Eoff St, for handicapped parking space in front of residence. Ms. Cecil was present and spoke on behalf of approving the request. Member King, seconded by Member Duffy to recommend the following traffic rule to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE: 4672: TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE IN THE WEST SIDE OF EOFF STREET DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 3834 EOFF STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON EOFF STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET

Request by John and Judy Monahan for handicapped parking space located at residence of 4006 Wood St. Mrs. Monahan called the City Clerks office prior to the meeting and stated they were unable to attend meeting. After evaluation of the property Commissioners approved the request. Member King, seconded by Member Duffy to recommend the following traffic rule to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE: 4673: TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE IN THE EAST SIDE OF WOOD STREET DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 4006 WOOD STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON WOOD STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET

Request by Orphy Klempa, Virginia Apartments, to remove the yellow line and no parking zone

on 9th Street. Mr. Klempa was present to explain need for request. After on site evaluation by commission Member King, seconded by Member Duffy to recommend the following traffic rule to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE: 4674: TO ESTABLISH AN UNRESTRICTED PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF 9TH STREET BEGINNING 10 FEET EAST ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF MAIN STREET AND 9TH STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION ON 9TH STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 153 FEET

Request by Jeremy Puglisi, 2021 Hornbrook Ave, for a no parking zone directly across from residential driveway. Member Duvall, seconded by Member Duffy to table this until next meeting. A written objection was received by the City Clerks office.

Request by Martha Francis, 327 Chestnut Ave, for a no parking zone directly across from residential driveway. After an onsite inspection and clarification conversations with Ms. Francis; Member King, seconded by Member Duffy to recommend the following traffic rule to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE: 4675: TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE WEST SIDE OF CHESTNUT AVENUE ACROSS FROM THE DRIVEWAY LOCATED AT 327 CHESTNUT AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON CHESTNUT AVENUE FOR A DISTANCE OF 15 FEET.

Request by Tim Birch, Operations Superintendent, for metered zone on Lane 7 to be no parking from the hours of 3am to 7am to allow sanitation trucks to pass. Member Duffy, seconded by Member King to recommend the following traffic rule to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE: 4676: TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE BETWEEN 3AM AND 7AM ON THE SOUTHSIDE OF LANE 7 BEGINNING 6 FEET WEST OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF MARKET STREET AND LANE 7, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION ON LANE 7 FOR A DISTANCE OF 19 FEET

Request by Vagabond Kitchen, 1201 Market St., to change size of current loading zones to allow addition of more meters. No one present to speak on behalf of request. Member Duffy, seconded by Member King to recommend the following traffic rule to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE: 4677: TO ESTABLISH A 2 HOUR PARKING METER ZONE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8AM AND 6PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF 12<sup>TH</sup> STREET BEGINNING 3 FEET FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF MARKET STREET AND 12 STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION ON 12<sup>TH</sup> STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 68 FEET

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Member Duffy, seconded by Member King, to adjourn. Motion carried. Time: 2:36 PM.
