**WHEELING TRAFFIC COMMISSION**  
**October 10, 2019**

The Wheeling Traffic Commission met for its monthly business meeting on the above date in City Council Chambers with Chair Duvall presiding. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS:

Request by Carrie Lough, for a handicapped parking to be placed in front of residence at 417 Warwood Ave. Ms. Lough was present to speak on behalf of request. There is no off-street parking. Mr. Duffy moved, seconded by Mr. Adams to recommend the rule below to Council. All in favor. Motion carried.

TRAFFIC RULE 4731: TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE ON THE WEST SIDE OF WARWOOD AVENUE DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 417 WARWOOD AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON WARWOOD AVENUE FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET. TRAFFIC RULE SUBJECT TO TWO YEAR LIMITATION- RULE EXPIRES 11/20/2021

Request by Renew and Refinishing & Restoration for loading zone to be place in front of business located at 2128 Main St. Sarah's on Main, adjacent business owner, was present to speak on this request. Sarah Lydick is accepting of a rule to allow meter parking half of the day and loading zone the other half. No one from Renew and Refinishing was present. Mr. Duffy moved, seconded by Mr. King to table the request.

Request by Nicole Whorton for Stop Sign at the intersection of Hawthorn Ct and Hawthorne Ct. A petition signed by neighbors was submitted to the Commission in favor of this request. Mr. Birth reviews traffic study that was completed in the area, and recommends three stop signs are placed. Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. Knierim, moved the rule below to Council. INTERSECTION, STOPPING TRAFFIC MOVING IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION ON EMERSON ROAD AND STOPPING TRAFFIC MOVING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION ON HAWTHORN ROAD

TRAFFIC RULE 4733: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP OF THE CITY OF WHEELING, DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF ARCHIBALD AVENUE, EMERSON ROAD, AS A STOP INTERSECTION FOR TRAFFIC MOVING IN AN EASTERLY, WESTERLY, AND SOUTHERNLY DIRECTION THROUGH THIS INTERSECTION.

Request by Tim Birch, for the intersection of Lane D and Lane 23 making it a 3-way stop. Stopping Southbound, Eastbound and Westbound traffic at this intersection. Mr. Duffy moved, seconded by Mr. Adams to recommend the rule below to Council. All in favor. Motion carried

Mr. Duffy moved, seconded by Mr. Knierim to table the following request until proper notification was given. Request by Sgt. Sanders for metered parking on 22<sup>nd</sup> St. near Chapline (in front of the church, north side of the road), request by Sgt. Sanders to remove the loading zone near 2208 Chapline; NB lane on the east side of the market house, request by Sgt. Sanders to remove loading zone in front of 1073 Main St.

Request by Sgt. Sanders to remove stop sign at the intersection of 18<sup>th</sup> and Market St. 18<sup>th</sup> street was abandoned by the City of Wheeling and given to West Virginia Northern Community College. Mr. Knierim moved, seconded by Mr. Duffy to recommend the rule below to Council. All in favor. Motion carried.

TRAFFIC RULE 4734: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP OF THE CITY OF WHEELING, DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF MARKET STREET AND 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET AS A THROUGH INTERSECTION FOR TRAFFIC MOVING IN A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION ON MARKET STREET
