The Wheeling Traffic Commission met for its monthly business meeting on the above date in City Council Chambers with Chair Duvall presiding. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS:

Request by Renew and Refinishing & Restoration for loading zone to be place in front of business located at 2128 Main St. No one from Renew and Refinishing was present. Mr. Duffy moved, seconded by Mr. King to table the request.

Request by Robert Fisher for Handicapped Parking to be placed in front of residence, 11 Elmwood Place. Mr. Fisher was present to speak on behalf of his request. Clerk Delbert confirmed there was one letter of support from a neighbor, 27 Elmwood Street. No one else present to speak for or against the request. Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. King, moved to recommend the following rule to Council. Motion carried. All in favor.

TRAFFIC RULE 3736: TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ELMWOOD PLACE DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 11 ELMWOOD PLACE, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON ELMWOOD PLACE FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET. SUBJECT TO TWO-YEAR LIMITATION

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WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON JACOB FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET. SUBJECT TO TWO-YEAR LIMITATION

Request by Jackie Weisenborn for Handicapped Parking to be placed in front of residence, 5 Pearl Ave. Ms. Weisenborn was present to speak on behalf of her request. No one else was present to speak for or against her request. Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. Knierim, moved to recommend the following rule to Council. Motion carried. All in favor.

TRAFFIC RULE 3738: TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE ON THE EAST SIDE OF PEARL AVE ST DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 5 PEARL AVE, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON PEARL AVE FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET. SUBJECT TO TWO-YEAR LIMITATION

Request by Janet Starchura for Handicapped Parking to be placed in front of residence, 3904 Wetzel Street. Ms. Starchura's daughter Carla was present to speak on mother's behalf. No one else was present to speak for or against the request. Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved to recommend the following rule to Council. Motion carried. All in favor.

TRAFFIC RULE 3739: TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE ON THE EAST SIDE OF WETZEL STREET DIRECTLY ACROSS FROM 3904 WETZEL STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON WETZEL STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 22 FEET

Request by Dave Delbrugge for a no parking Zone on Wells Street. Mr. Delbrugge is present to speak on his request. Assistant Fire Chief Jameson, spoke in favor of a fire lane. Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved for a no parking zone to allow for a fire lane. Motion Carried. All in favor. The following traffic rule is recommended to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE 3740: TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WELLS STREET BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF GC&P AND WELLS STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION ON WELLS STREET TO ECONOMY STREET



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Request by Conaway Flooring for no parking zone adjacent to driveway. Chris Hamm was present to discuss in favor of the request. Mr. Knierim, seconded by Mr. Duffy, moved for a no parking zone. Motion Carried. All in favor. The following traffic rule is recommended to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE 3743: TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE EAST SIDE OF MAIN STREET BEGINNING 148 FEET NORTH OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF 22ND STREET AND MAIN STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION ON MAIN STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 20 FEET

Request by Sgt. Sanders to remove two loading zones for additional metered parking on 22<sup>nd</sup> St. near Chapline Request by Sgt. Sanders to remove the loading zone near 2208 Chapline; NB lane on the east side of the market house. Sgt. Sanders was not present to speak to request. Philip Stahl, Public Information Officer, addressed the commission on Sgt. Sanders behalf.

Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. King, moved for a meter zone to be placed. Motion Carried. All in favor. The following traffic rule is recommended to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE 3741 TO ESTABLISH A 2 HOUR PARKING METER ZONE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8 AM AND 5 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, ON THE NORTH SIDE OF 22<sup>ND</sup> STREET BEGINNING 11 FEET WEST OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF CHAPLINE STREET AND 22<sup>ND</sup> STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION ON 22<sup>ND</sup> STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 103 FEET

Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Knierim, moved for a no parking zone. Motion Carried. All in favor. The following traffic rule is recommended to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE 3742 TO ESTABLISH A 2 HOUR PARKING METER ZONE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8 AM AND 5 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHBOUND SECTION OF MARKET STREET BEGINNING 12 FEET SOUTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF 22<sup>ND</sup> STREET AND MARKET STREET, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A SOUTHERLY



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DIRECTION ON MARKET STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF  
101 FEET

Request by Sgt. Sanders to remove loading zone in front of 1073 Main St. Sarel Venter was present to speak in opposition of removal. Although the business that is directly in front of loading zone is gone, others on the block still use frequently. Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. King, to table request until December meeting.

Mr. Duvall, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved to table the following agenda items until clarification could be obtained from OVRTA; Request for loading Zone to be placed on 11th St. at the intersection of 11th and Market St, Request for a handicapped meter to be placed in front of Titos Sloppy Doggs, 1068 Market St, Request for a 2- hour Parking Meter Zone 1068 Market Street to 1056 Market, Request for a 2-hour Parking Meter Zone on the 1100 Block from 12th and Market to Subway.

Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Duvall, to accept a form to be used as a formal request for traffic commission changes. (please see attached)
