WHEELING TRAFFIC COMMISSION
January 16, 2020

The Wheeling Traffic Commission met for its monthly business meeting on the above date in City Council Chambers with Chair Duvall presiding. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS:

Request by Dave Palmer for No Parking Zone on the even side of Hurst Ave in Springdale to allow for a Fire Lane. No one was present to speak for or against the request, however Clerk Delbert indicated she received a neighbor email in favor of request. Mr. King, seconded by Mr. Knierim, to approve as requested. Motion Carried. All in favor. The following traffic rule is recommended to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE 4755: TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE WEST SIDE OF HURST AVE. BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SPRINGDALE AVE AND HURST AVE, IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION ON HURST AVE TO THE END OF HURST AVE.

Request by Melinda Koslik to remove meters in the residential section of Eoff Street, particularly 2224 Eoff Street, since the closure of OVMC parking is not in high demand. Rusty Jebbia, Public Works Director, is present to present this request. He expresses the goal is to allow residence to park in front of their house in the section consisting of 23rd St. to Lane 19 on the East and West Side. Mr. Knierim, seconded by Mr. Duffy, to approve as requested. Motion Carried. All in favor. The following traffic rule is recommended to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE 4756: TO ESTABLISH UNRESTRICTED PARKING ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDE OF EOFF ST. BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF LANE 19 AND EOFF ST., IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION ON EOFF ST TO THE INTERSECTION OF 23RD ST.

Request by Dr. Carlos Jimenez to change the parking meters located in front of his practice, 41 15th St., from 15 minutes to 2-hours, and change the two parking meters located in front of his practice, 41 15th St., to handicap meters. Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. Adams, moved to grant the request. Motion Carried. All in favor. The following traffic rule is recommended to Council:

TRAFFIC RULE 4757: TO ESTABLISH A 2-HOUR METERED HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 AM AND 5:00 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF 41 15TH ST., IN THE CITY OF WHEELING, AND EXTENDING ON 15TH ST FOR A DISTANCE OF 44 FEET.

There being no further business to discuss Mr. Knierim, seconded by Mr. Adams to adjourn. Time 2:12 p.m.
