WHEELING TRAFFIC COMMISSION

The Wheeling Traffic Commission met for its monthly business meeting on the above date in City Managers Conference Room with Chair Duvall presiding. The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

Mr. Knierim, moved, seconded by Mr. Adams, to approve the March 11, 2021 Minutes as received.

Request for Parking Meters to be installed at 830,832, and 834 Main St. Mr. Lanham indicated he has spoken to the applicant and they are withdrawing their request.

Request for 39th St. Between Jacob and Water Street to allow two-way traffic. Tom Simons with Chandan Engineering is present and speaks on behalf of request. Mr. Elmer Roth, 3820 Eoff St., speaks against the request. James Ellis, 3836 Eoff St., speaks against the request. Mr. Simons asked if there would still be an objection if only partially of the street was converted. Commissioners and citizens present indicated there is still an objection. Mr. Duvall moves, seconded by Mr. Duffy, to approve. The vote on the motion is as follows: Yes- Mr. Adams and Mr. Knierim; NO- Mr. Duvall, Mr. Duffy, and Mr. King. Motion denied.

Request for meter located at 2227 Chapline St. to be converted to Handicapped parking meter. A representative from Panhandle Support Services to speak on behalf of the request. Mr. King moved, seconded by Mr. Duffy, to convert the meter closest to the corner to a handicapped parking meter. All in favor. Motion passes and will be forwarded to City Council.
